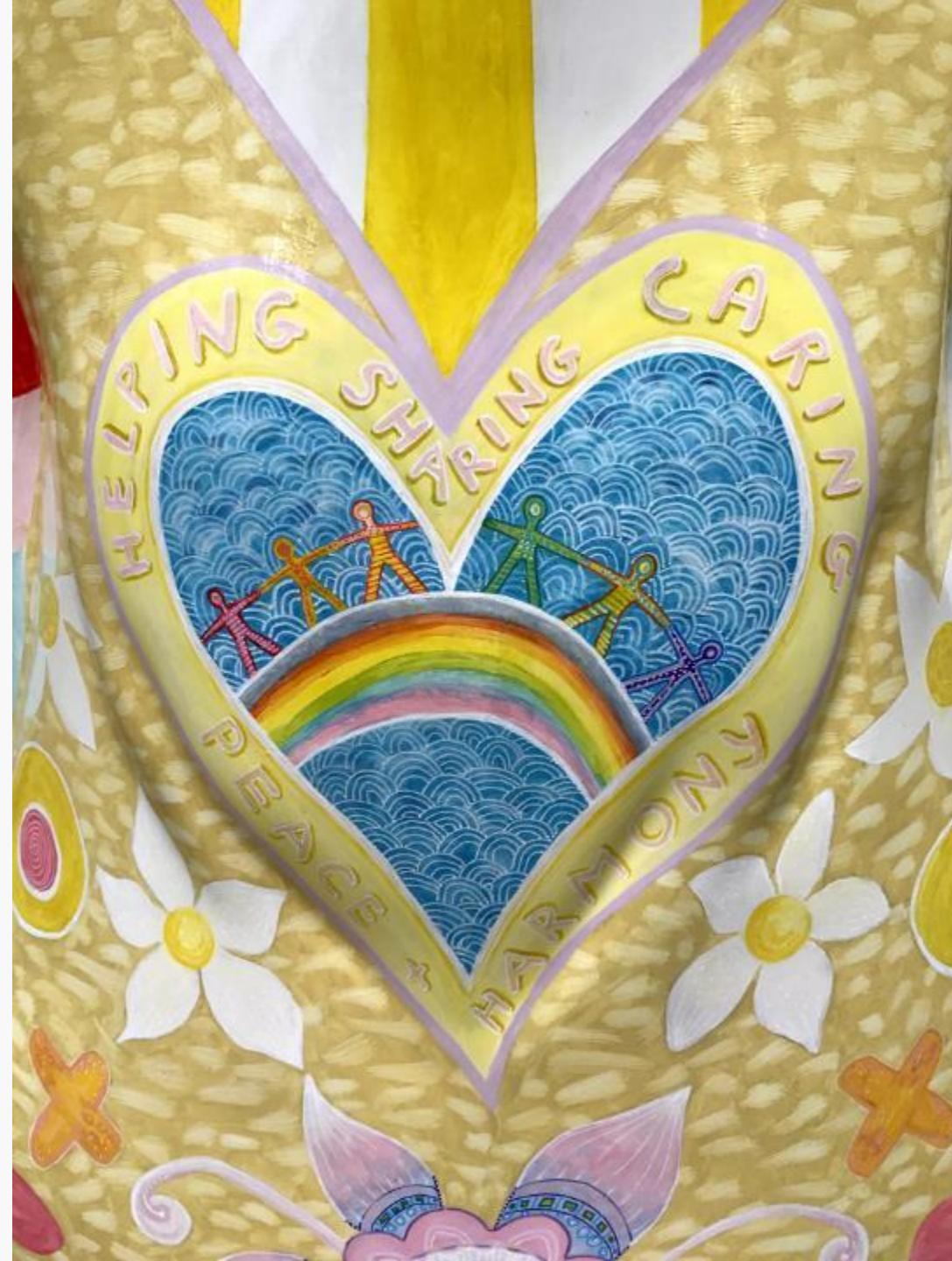

world.*

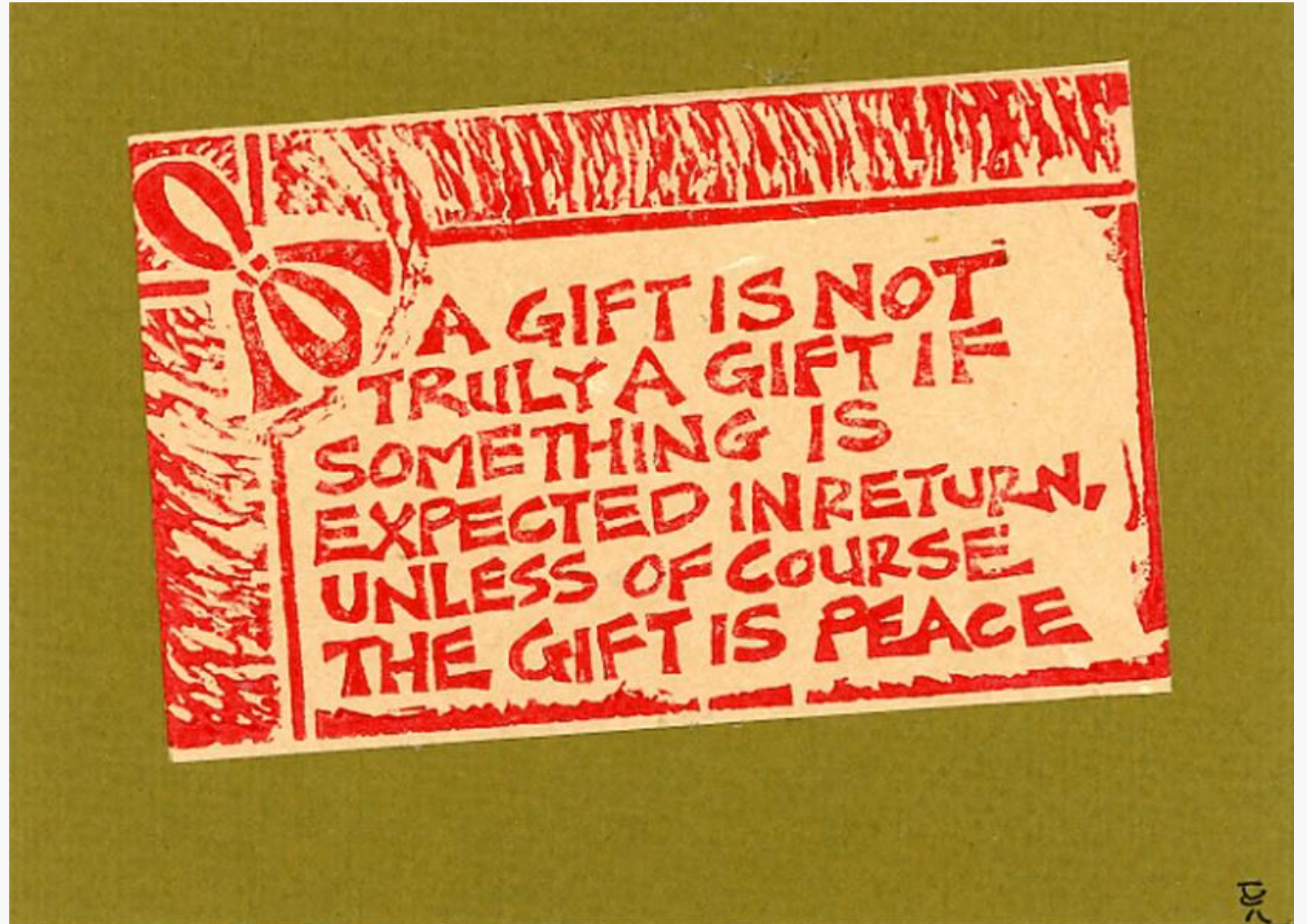
*Third Friday of Advent, Year B*
