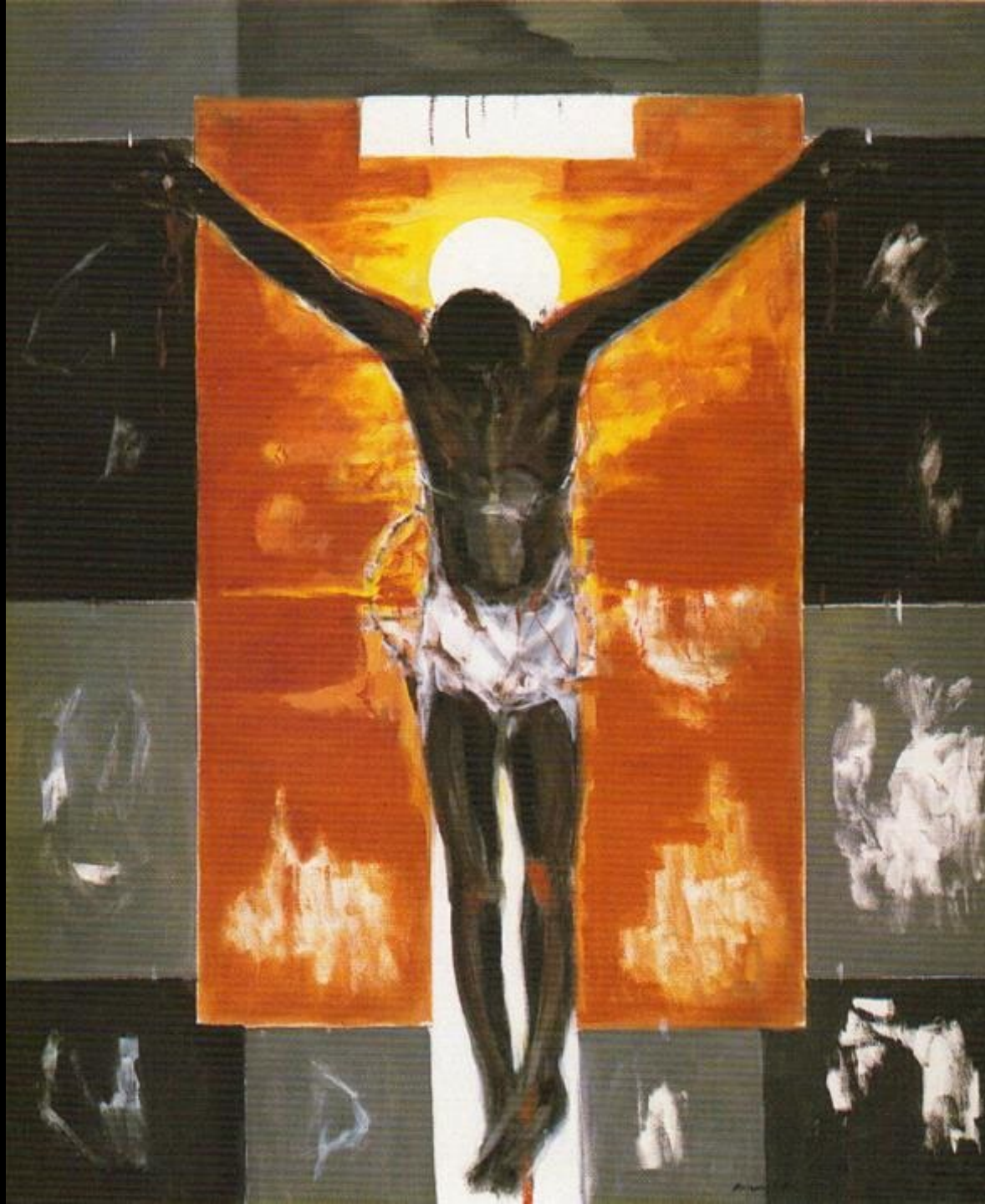

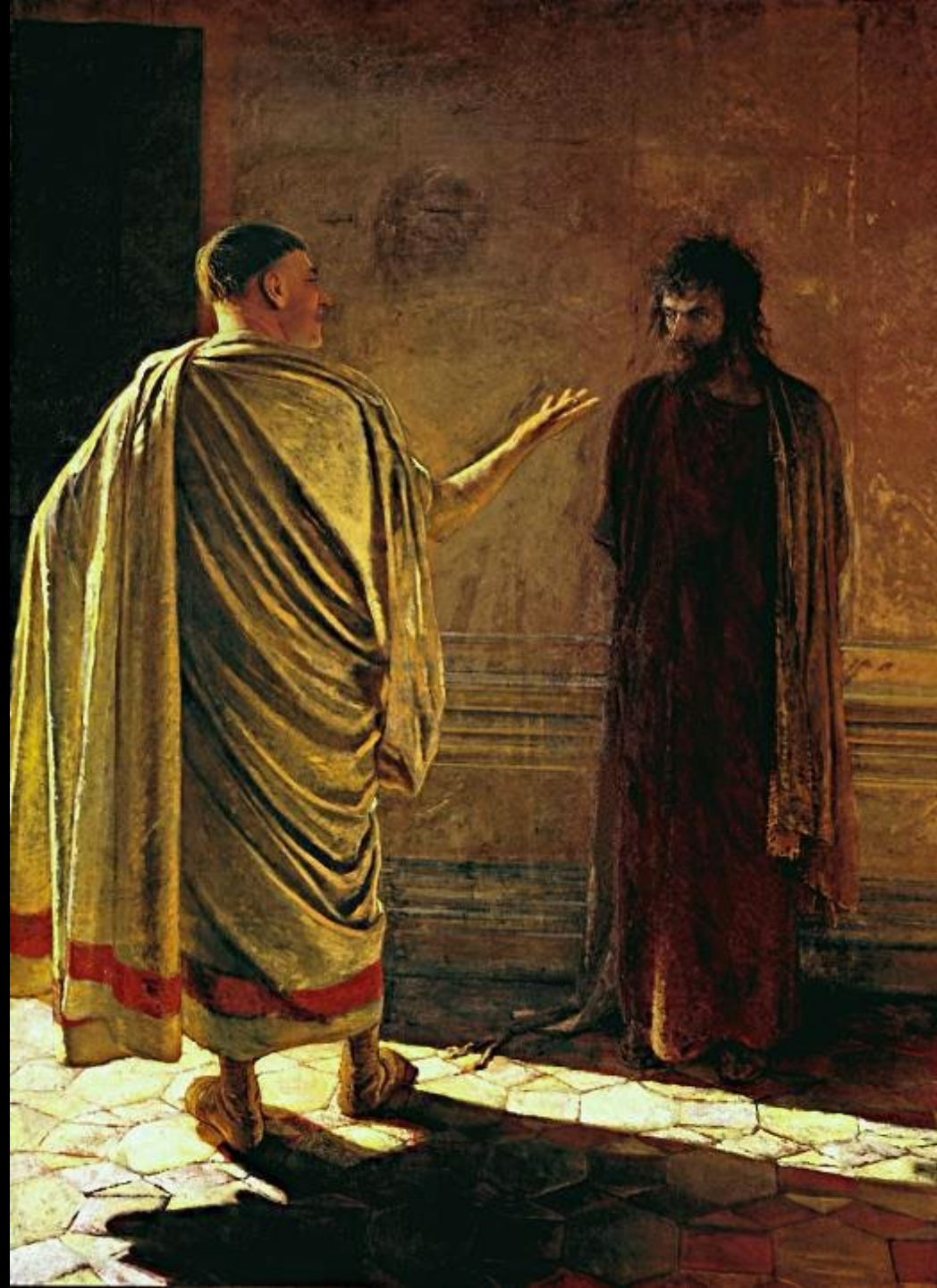

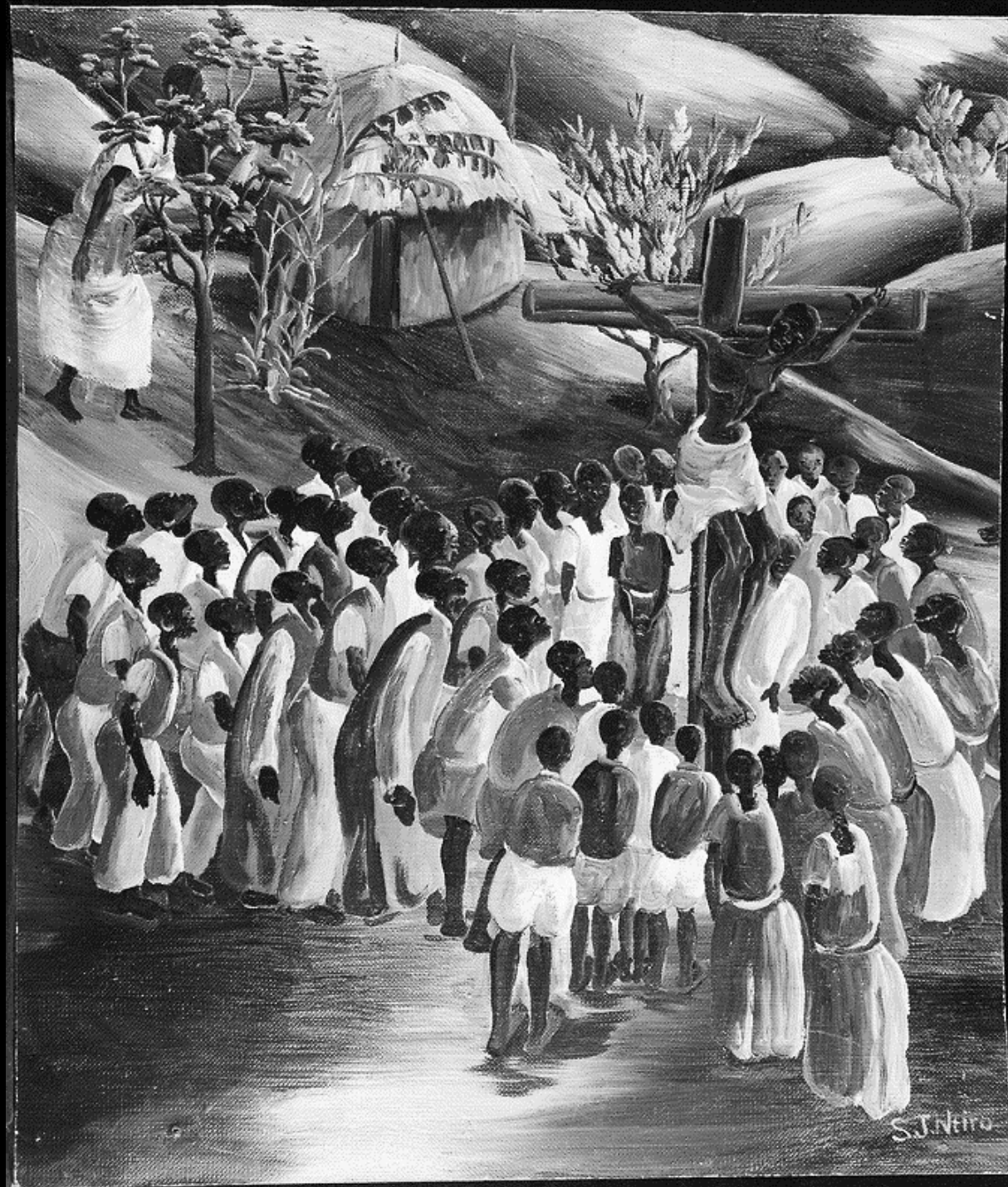


Procesión del Vía Crucis, Las Mesas, Lázaro Cárdenas, Tlaxcala
